We will be learning to...

- listen carefully to stories and rhymes
- know how to respond appropriately when asked
- maintain attention in small and whole class contexts
- follow one step instructions

## Literacy

We will be learning to...

- recognise our own name
- read from left to right and know that print carries meaning
- show interest in illustrations and print
- draw lines and circles
- write own name by copying it from a name card or try to write it from memory
- give meaning to marks
- know grapheme correspondence for 19 letters
- orally blend words
- begin to segment words for spelling

## Expressive Arts and Design

We will be learning to...

- grip a pencil comfortably and explore making marks, creating lines and circles
- explore working with paint on different surfaces and in different ways using a variety of brushes
- explore colour mixing
- draw and paint self portraits
- safely pass scissors to another person
- use scissors to make snips in paper
- create a collage
- join in with singing and ring games
- use various construction materials

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be learning to...

- show an awareness of the behavioral expectations of Pirbright School
- be aware of own feelings
- talk about feelings using words like 'happy', 'sad', 'angry'
- celebrate our individuality and uniqueness
- work together as a class to follow rules
- select and use activities and resources
- make new friendships and play

We will be learning to...

- talk about and understand changes in our own lifetime, by discussing how we have changed from a baby
- describe what they see, hear, and feel outside

## Physical Development

We will be learning to...

- use one handed tools and equipment
- begin to form recognisable letters
- explore moving in different ways – crawling, rolling, jumping, hopping
- travel on different pathways using the space around them
- send and receive different sized balls
- experiment safely with a range of equipment
- manage washing and drying of hands
- use the toilet independently
