



Dear Parents,

Welcome back! We hope you have all enjoyed a happy and healthy Christmas and are feeling recharged and raring to go into the spring term. We thank you for a wonderful first term and we can't wait for another action-packed term, as outlined on the topic web. This term, our topic is 'Living, Dead and Never Been Alive'. As always, you will be able to see a weekly overview on our home learning sheet to keep you informed of our objectives and up-to-date with school news and important dates.

School bags: Please ensure that your child brings their book in their bag every day. Your child can change their additional sharing book as often as they like. Please think about the size of the bag that is brought in. The Year 2 cloakroom cubbies are relatively small and it is important that all of their belongings can fit. We would like to remind everyone that toys are not permitted in school.

Home Learning: For the spring term your child will continue to bring home their home learning folder and home learning sheet on a Friday and they both need to be returned to school the following Thursday. Please ensure home learning folders and sheets are both returned so we can keep you informed about spelling test results. The activities are split into essential tasks (reading and Mathletics) that relate to the Year 2 learning objectives and further tasks to provide opportunities for curriculum enrichment.

Reading: It is essential for all children to read regularly at home, ideally every day. At school, your child will continue to read in a variety of ways – individual reading, buddy reading, guided reading and shared reading of a variety of texts.

Class assemblies: 2CD's class assembly is on Friday 30th January and 2BT's class assembly is on Friday 13th February.

PE: It is important that your child brings their full P.E. kit (royal blue T-shirt & shorts, trainers and a dark, plain tracksuit for outdoor P.E) to school on a **Monday** and takes it home on a **Friday** for washing. Base layers may also be worn during PE lessons. Earrings are not to be worn during PE and hair longer than shoulder length needs to be tied back. Please supply a pair of socks, if tights are worn.

School trip: For our school trip this term, we will be visiting Nower Wood on Monday 23rd March 2025. A letter with all the information on will be given out soon.
