If you would like to take on the Reading Challenge, then you need to be a **FREE READER** first. Choose a challenge from the leaflets below and stick it into your reading record – if you need any help ask any of the adults who work in your class, Mrs Dow or a librarian.

The challenges are split into two types of challenge...

Books Provided	Books to Find
<p>You will find the books in the boxes on the Reading Challenge shelves below. They are all clearly labelled for you. You can do the challenges in any order but for difficulty, they go Amethyst, Diamond, Garnet. Choose the books from the challenge that you fancy reading, fill out your grid and get going!</p>	<p>This challenge gives you the author but you must find the book in the library. You can find ANY book by the author. It helps you to practice your book hunting skills and lets you choose from a selection of books. For example, it might say "Roald Dahl" so browse the Roald Dahl section and choose a book you think you would like.</p>
<p>Amethyst: Good books for children who are now Free Readers. Some children will find these easy; some children will find them more of a challenge.</p>	<p>Jade: Authors who usually write shorter books for children, a good place to get going.</p>
<p>Diamond: Slightly trickier (and longer) recommended books for children who are Free Readers.</p>	<p>Pearl: Authors who usually write slightly longer and more challenging books for children.</p>
<p>Garnet: The Classics (or new classics)! Tricky books for very good readers.</p>	<p>Topaz: The last Reading Challenge to complete! You have read 50 books in the Pirbright Challenge plus 100s in the books banded levels – be free and make good choices! Enjoy the library!</p>
