They will be committed to doing their very best at the club, showing their Pirbright Values with both behavior and learning attitudes.

They will persevere with new skills and stick at the club for the half-term.

They will get to clubs on promptly and not waste any time after school.

They will let staff know if they cannot attend a club before the session with an apology.

They will remember our Pirbright Values and make sure they thank the staff and any helpers involved in the club each week.

Pirbright Parents

You will ensure you sign up for clubs using the SCOPAY system so we have a register for each session. Children can only be signed up to **one** club for each possible session.
Please do not claim more than one space as children can not be in two different clubs at once!

You will make the adult who runs the club (or the school office) aware of any instance that your child cannot attend a session.

You will encourage your child to adhere to their agreement in the charter.
