Club	Description
School reporters	Brush up on your journalistic skills by reporting on some of the exciting things we get up to in school. You could interview teachers, report on events and you might even get to see your work on the weekly newsletter!
Girls' Football	Girls in Key Stage Two are invited to come along on Wednesday lunchtimes to develop their footballing skills and take part in some fun, small-sided games. Members of this club will form the core of our squad for any inter-school matches and tournaments.
Arts and Crafts	In Arts and Crafts club, we will become creators and have a go at painting, drawing, colouring, making things with junk modelling and even some outdoor crafts!
Harry Potter Fun and Games	Are you a Harry Potter fan? Then come along and have some fun immersing yourself in the wonders of the Wizarding World! We shall be reading sections of the first book, watching the first movie together, playing board themed board games and perhaps even a little magical makey-do!
Animation	In Animation Club, children can work as individuals or part of a group using a variety of different media including Lego and Playdoh to create short animations using the iPads. Children can also design their own comics and use different materials to bring them to life through animation on the iPads.
Cheerleading	Get ready to jump, tumble, and cheer your heart out! This term, children will dive into the high-energy world of cheerleading, starting with the exciting fundamentals: stunts, tumbling, jumps, and dance. Along the way, they'll build confidence, improve coordination, and learn the true value of teamwork in a supportive and fun environment. As the weeks progress, participants will master new skills and work together to create a dynamic group routine, showcasing everything they've learned. By the end of the term, they'll be ready to perform with spirit, strength, and synchronization — just like a real cheer squad!
Football	A club open to boys and girls who enjoy their football; we focus on skills as well as take part in fun, small-sided games. Members of this club will form the core of our squads for local matches over the season. An opportunity to get active, play structured small-sided games and aim to represent the school in interschool festivals and leagues.

Puzzles & Board Games	An opportunity to enjoy a range of different puzzles and board games and perhaps even create your own!
Netball	Children have the opportunity to practice and refine their key netballing skills such as passing, shooting, dodging, defending with a focus on High 5 rules and positions. Applying their skills to game situations is always the focus of netball club and these take place during the sessions where we mix children up and challenge them to play each other. Some children will be chosen from netball club to represent the school in the league games we play.
Crest Award (Science)	Children will work through tasks in order to achieve their CREST Superstar Award, a nationally recognised science program of study for primary school children. Activities will vary each week and allow children to practice their investigative skills alongside developing their knowledge and understanding of the world. This club is for children who have NOT completed their CREST Award in previous years.
Lego	A club where we will design, test and build using LEGO bricks! We will complete various design challenges that will allow us to imagine, create and work together. We will also be discovering how to use technology to plan our designs and record our progress.
Chess	Chess is an ancient two-player strategy board game played on a chessboard, a checkered game board with 64 squares arranged in an eight-by-eight grid. No experience is required to join this club and all equipment will be provided. For the first few weeks, we learn the rules of the game and enjoy some friendly games against players of a similar level. After that, we play a series of knockout matches to compete for the prestigious title of Pirbright chess champion!
Drawing	Come along and follow step by step tutorials to produce a variety of drawings. From cartoon tv characters, vehicles and animals... we will draw it all!
Computing	In computing club, we use the laptops, the iPads and the micro:bits to enjoy learning new computer skills.
Lacrosse	POP Lacrosse is a 5v5 stick and ball invasion game, for boys and girls, that can be played on a badminton court-sized space or similar. The aim of the game is to score a goal by shooting or rolling a ball into the opponent's net. Our club will be played outside either on the Field or the Netball courts weather depending.
