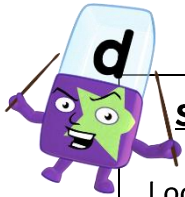


Year R Reading Tasks

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>SOUND ISPY</u></p> <p>Look through the book and play ispy. "I spy with my little eye the sound 'a'" and ask your child to spot it.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>TRICKY WORD HUNT</u></p> <p>Look though the book and hunt the tricky words.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>NON-FICTION BOOKS</u></p> <p>What did you find out? What special vocabulary did you learn?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>MY FAVOURITE PART</u></p> <p>Draw your favourite part of your book and explain why you like it.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>STORY SNAKE</u></p> <p>Draw a big S and retell your story from start to finish using drawings.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>FUNNY VOICES</u></p> <p>Improve expression when reading— You could try putting different voices on for the characters in your book.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>RE TELL</u></p> <p>Use small world characters to retell the story you have read. Can you change the ending?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>CHARACTER PROFILE</u></p> <p>Draw a picture of a character from your book. Write their name and three adjectives to describe them.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>ROLE-PLAY</u></p> <p>Can you dress up as one of the characters in the story? Can you role-play the story with your family? You could invent new characters or a new ending.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>QUIZ</u></p> <p>Make up at least five questions about your book. Make sure you know the answers!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>STOP!</u></p> <p>Stop after looking at the front cover and predict what will happen next. Stop at any point within in the book, review your prediction.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>NEW COVER</u></p> <p>Design a new cover for the book. Include a picture, title, author and illustrator.</p>
