Which character would you interview? What questions would you ask them and what do you think their answers might be?</p>

Test your friend (who has also read the book).</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>ACROSTIC POEM</u> Choose a character in your book and write an acrostic poem about them. Read it to a friend.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>BOOK REVIEW</u> Did you like or dislike your reading book? Explain why. Who would you recommend it to and why? How many stars would you 'rate' your book?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>WRITE A LETTER</u> Write a letter to one of the characters in your guided reading book. Include at least one question you want to ask them. What do you think their answer would be?</p>

Label it to add the main details of the story.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>WHAT NEXT?</u> Predict what might happen in a sequel to the story. Write down what happens to each character.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>TIMELINE</u> Using pictures explain the order of events in your reading book. Label each picture.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>HOLIDAY DESTINATION</u> Describe where the story took place (setting). Can you write a travel guide advertising reasons to visit the place?</p>

Include their appearance and likes or dislikes.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>STORY MOUNTAIN</u> Create a story mountain showing the journey the main character takes.
