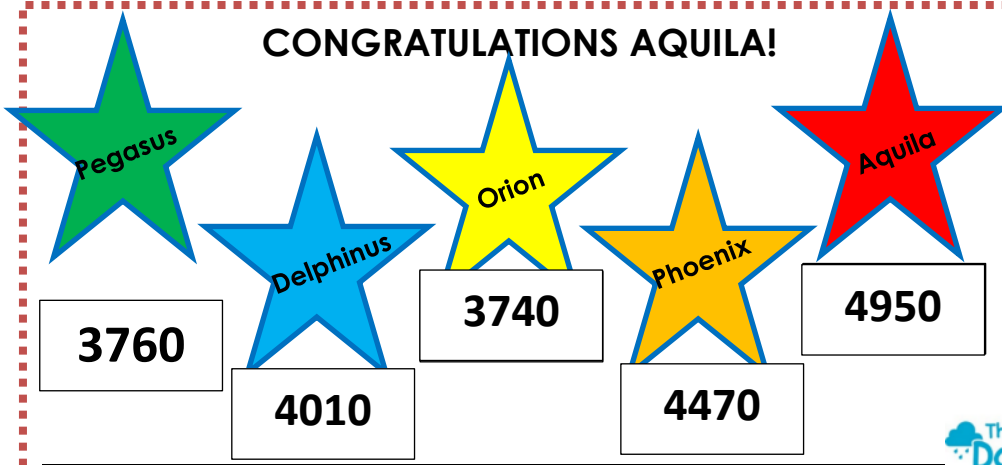

### UNIFORM

We reviewed our uniform policy this time last year and gave parents lots of warning about the fact we would be tightening up on it and on the whole, it has been a great year so far. However, there are a few things which are starting to creep back in so we would just like to clarify and look forward to the children returning after Easter, in the correct uniform.

- **Boots are not a part of school uniform.** Children should not be wearing boots during the school day. If they need to wear them to walk to school, then they should change into shoes on arrival.
- **Trainers must be completely black.** We added trainers into the uniform policy for day to day wear as a way to support parents but some children are now wearing trainers which are black with other colours (white sole or pink bits for example) and this was not the agreement. Children must be in totally black trainers or we will revert to all children wearing school shoes and no trainers will be allowed.
- **Earrings** should be a plain stud (gold, silver, pearl, “diamond” or a plain colour). Not a sparkly, fancy stud or anything with a drop or a character or a shape like a leaf, kiss, flower or any variation. Just a plain stud. The other option is no earrings at all, so please ensure children are following the rules and we won't have to ban them completely.
- **PE Shorts are different to cycling short.** Children must have PE shorts for lessons and will not be allowed to take part if they are trying to wear their cycling shorts only.
- **Cycling shorts** can be worn under dresses, we totally understand this, but they need to be in school colours (black, white, blue or grey).

Dear Parent,

**Re: invite to help us develop a quick and easy test for chickenpox**

We are looking for any children aged 3-11 years who may have chickenpox. We've been informed by your school/nursery that there have been children with chickenpox in your school/nursery. We are looking for your help to test a quick and pain free way to check if your child has chickenpox using a mouth swab sample.

Your participation is **completely voluntary** and would be greatly appreciated, but if you choose not to participate, this will not affect your child's healthcare or education in any way.

Chickenpox is common and mostly affects children, but you can get it at any age. For more information about chickenpox, please see NHS Choices - <https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/chickenpox/>.

We would like to be able to test for chickenpox in the same way that we test for other infections such as measles and we are currently looking to develop a test for this which is quick, easy to perform and completely pain free. It involves wiping a soft sponge inside your child's mouth, along their gums. We would send you a kit to do this together with a pre-paid and pre-labelled return envelope.

We will not collect details of your child together with the sample provided, once you have received the sampling kit, the process will be completely anonymised and therefore we won't be able to provide you with the results.

**If your child currently has chickenpox, we would like to invite you to do the following:**

1. We will send a kit to your home if you email us your address on [iduqueries@ukhsa.gov.uk](mailto:iduqueries@ukhsa.gov.uk).
2. Complete the form that comes with the kit.
3. Use the swab as soon as possible after the onset of your child's rash and **no later than 7 days after onset of rash**, marking the date of the swab on the accompanying form.
4. If this is not possible within this time, but you have another child who got chickenpox later, you can use the swab on them (as early as possible and within 7 days of the onset of the rash) instead.
5. Please follow instructions for taking and returning the swab, a pre-paid and labelled envelope will be provided
