FoodWise is a local charity that runs two friendly community food outlets called **ShopWise**. They sit somewhere between a supermarket and a food bank, offering families an affordable way to top up their weekly shop. At ShopWise, there's no referral process and no need to share personal details - just a warm welcome for anyone who'd like to make their budget stretch a little further.

Families can visit once a week and pay a flat rate of £3 per visit. For that, you'll receive a free bag of fresh fruit and vegetables, plus ten "points" to use on a wide variety of grocery items. Most items cost just one point, and some are available in great value bundles like "three for a point." There's always a nice selection on the shelves. You can just turn up if you need to.

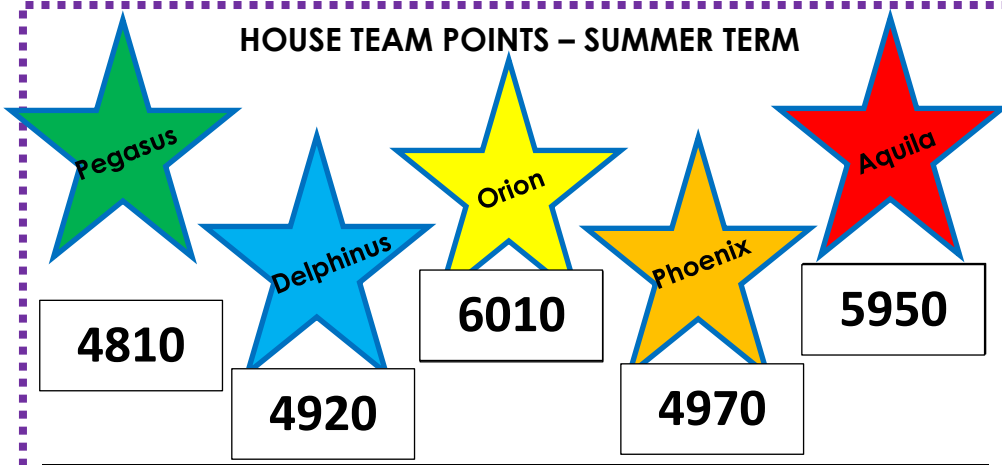

AI Generated Videos

AI can now generate realistic looking videos that are almost impossible to distinguish from genuine content. From hoax news to abusive deepfakes, these synthetic clips can mislead, manipulate and even harm. As AI tools become more advanced, and more accessible, young people are increasingly at risk of encountering fake but convincing footage online. This #WakeUpWednesday guide unpacks the dangers of AI-generated videos, from the emotional impact of fake distressing content to the potential for impersonation and bullying. With practical tips to help young users spot deepfakes and navigate online spaces with confidence, this guide is an essential read for parents navigating this rapidly evolving digital landscape.

A Guide to the Christmas Productions for New Parents (& Old Parents Who Need a Reminder...)

Reception: Reception will perform their own nativity show in a separate performance. All parents are welcome to four seats in the hall and do not need to book online. It's on Thursday 11th December at 10am. Children will be busy singing and learning their lines; teachers might be smiling nicely at you for costumes... There is no room in the hall so if you have a pushchair you will be asked to leave it outside – babies can be in arms and don't need a ticket!

Key Stage 1: Year 1 and 2 take to the stage for their performance. Class teachers will be providing pupils with scripts and lines to be learnt, where appropriate, and you may find teachers trying to catch you on the door to discuss any costume options! Two performances take place in the afternoon of Plays Week. They usually start at 1.30 with the shows expected to be finished before the end of the school day, giving just enough time for pupils to get changed and be ready for collection at the usual time. The shows are on Wednesday 10th and Thursday 11th December. Pre-school aged children can come on Wednesday (but are expected to be able to sit quietly – it is not a panto!). There is no room in the hall so if you have a pushchair you will be asked to leave it outside – babies can be in arms and don't need a ticket! Thursday is adults and older children only! We're very strict on this so please choose your performance wisely.

Key Stage 2 Production: This is run by Mr. Wright. Main parts are taken by the Year 6 pupils (they rehearse after school for weeks) with every year group having a song as part of the show. It's great to do something that involves everyone. Mrs Davies is at the helm of the singing which adds a little sparkle to proceedings. Year groups will come home with song words to learn; perhaps some other lines for their scenes as well as requests to help them with costumes. If you need any help then speak to the class teacher who can guide you in the right direction.

We have one performance during school time (Tuesday 9th – 1:30pm start) but the other performances are in the evening of the Plays Week (Wednesday 10th and Thursday 11th December). Pre-school aged children can come on Tuesday (but are expected to be able to sit quietly – it is not a panto!). There is no room in the hall so if you have a pushchair you will be asked to leave it outside – babies can be in arms and don't need a ticket! Wednesday & Thursday is adults and older children only. **Pupils need to be back at school for 6:30pm. It is really important for pupils to be back at school and to be part of the production, as this is a big part of belonging to the Pirbright family. If there is an exceptional reason for a child not to be back for a performance (such as illness) then please let the class teacher know as soon as possible.** On returning to school, children should have had their dinner at home. If you need to send them in with a healthy snack, please do so but it needs to follow normal school rules and not be chocolate or contain nuts.

We will give you an indication of end timings as soon as we know, usually around 8:30pm. Children can be collected from classroom doors whether you have seen the show or are just doing the pick-up. The front doors will only be for exiting after the show, so please don't use them to enter at the end of the evening to collect children. We will confirm timings when we have actually had a practise on the stage!

- Photos can be taken, but please don't put any images of other children on social media. Please also be mindful of phones blocking others' views.
- You must remain in your seat throughout the show. We need to keep exits clear for many reasons so please be seated and enjoy!
- Pre-schoolers are welcome on Tuesday & Wednesday afternoons. Neither show is interactive and neither is a panto so please ensure your tiny human is not spoiling the show for anyone else. If they can't sit quietly for the duration then please think about alternative child care.
- We will ask you to leave buggies and pushchairs (on Tuesday and Wednesday) outside so please prepare for this.
- You need a ticket for entry. If you don't have one or you have the wrong colour, you may have to wait until the end to be seated.

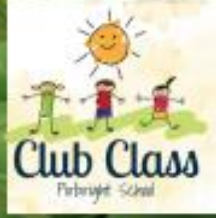
