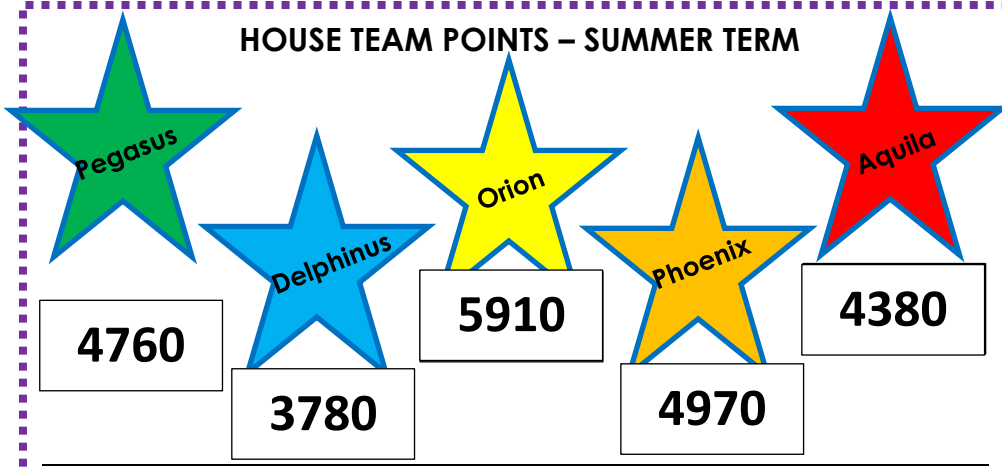

Festive Carols – No Room at the Inn...

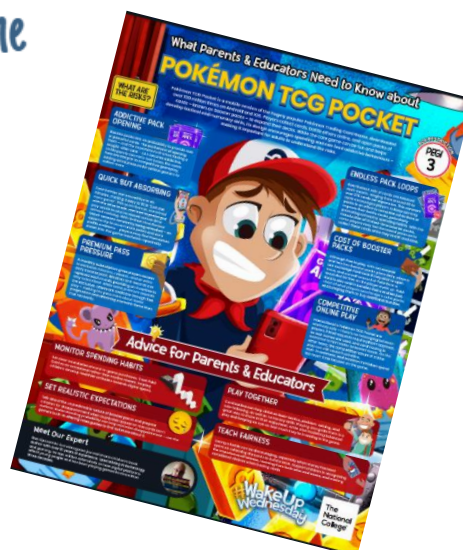

The first wave of Christmas production tickets has been very successful with 759 tickets allocated on Thursday by the ticketing fairies – this is up on last year by 150 so it was a VERY busy day at HQ! The Box Office has now reopened for Phase 2 of ticketing where you are welcome to select some more tickets. Based on the numbers, we have added in a question regarding if you have already had tickets this week. All being well (and people making sensible requests for tickets that don't involve their second cousin from Norwich wanting to see the show) we shouldn't need to use it, but if requests are too high, we will prioritise those who haven't already had tickets. And we will double check - answering honestly would be very helpful. We have spent time sticking 41 stickers on 41 family's ticket requests who have over-ordered based on the rules. This is valuable time which could be spent on many other things in school, so would really appreciate parents following the KS2 rules of a **MAXIMUM OF TWO EVENING TICKETS PER FAMILY.**

Based on the current numbers, you are welcome to select "the same again" so please see details on each of the forms which you can access below. In short, KS1 can have two more per afternoon; KS2 is two for **one** evening (or split between two evenings) and an additional two for Tuesday afternoon. Please use the links below but note that options may disappear as they "sell-out" – Mrs Dow will keep an eye on it over the week.

A Guide to the Christmas Productions for New Parents (& Old Parents Who Need a Reminder...)

At this time of year across the school, staff are busy preparing pupils for our Christmas shows, if you have not been to one at Pirbright before, you are in for a treat!

Reception: Reception will perform their own nativity show in a separate performance. All parents are welcome to four seats in the hall and do not need to book online. It's on Thursday 12th December at 10am. Children will be busy singing and learning their lines; teachers might be smiling nicely at you for costumes... There is no room in the hall so if you have a pushchair you will be asked to leave it outside – babies can be in arms and don't need a ticket!

Key Stage 1: Year 1 and 2 take to the stage for their performance. Class teachers will be providing pupils with scripts and lines to be learnt, where appropriate, and you may find teachers trying to catch you on the door to discuss any costume options! Two performances take place in the afternoon of Plays Week. They usually start at 1.30 with the shows expected to be finished before the end of the school day, giving just enough time for pupils to get changed and be ready for collection at the usual time. The shows are on Wednesday 11th and Thursday 12th December. Pre-school aged children can come on Wednesday (but are expected to be able to sit quietly – it is not a panto!). There is no room in the hall so if you have a pushchair you will be asked to leave it outside – babies can be in arms and don't need a ticket! Thursday is adults and older children only! We're very strict on this so please choose your performance wisely.

Key Stage 2 Production: This is run by Mr. Wright. Main parts are taken by the Year 6 pupils (they rehearse after school for weeks) with every year group having a song as part of the show. It's great to do something that involves everyone. Mrs Davies is at the helm of the singing which adds a little sparkle to proceedings. Year groups will come home with song words to learn; perhaps some other lines for their scenes as well as requests to help them with costumes. If you need any help then speak to the class teacher who can guide you in the right direction.

We have one performance during school time (Tuesday 10th – 1:30pm start) but the other performances are in the evening of the Plays Week (Wednesday 11th and Thursday 12th December). Pre-school aged children can come on Tuesday (but are expected to be able to sit quietly – it is not a panto!). There is no room in the hall so if you have a pushchair you will be asked to leave it outside – babies can be in arms and don't need a ticket! Wednesday & Thursday is adults and older children only. **Pupils need to be back at school for 6:30pm. It is really important for pupils to be back at school and to be part of the production, as this is a big part of belonging to the Pirbright family. If there is an exceptional reason for a child not to be back for a performance (such as illness) then please let the class teacher know as soon as possible.** On returning to school, children should have had their dinner at home. If you need to send them in with a healthy snack, please do so but it needs to follow normal school rules and not be chocolate or contain nuts.

We will give you an indication of end timings as soon as we know, usually around 8:30pm. Children can be collected from classroom doors whether you have seen the show or are just doing the pick-up. The front doors will only be for exiting after the show, so please don't use them to enter at the end of the evening to collect children. We will confirm timings when we have actually had a practise on the stage!

Would you like to come and have a look at the wonderful learning that has been taking place in your child's classroom over the last half term? Then we are delighted to invite you to our first **Learning Look** of this academic year on **Friday 28th November** at **8.30am for KS2** and **8.45am for KS1 & EYFS**. This will give you the opportunity to look at books, displays and other pieces of work to celebrate your child's super learning with them. During the session, we would love you to chat to your child about what they are proud of and write a positive comment on a Proud Scroll about what has made you feel proud of them! Learning Looks are spread out across the school year and the dates and times for all of the sessions are on the school calendar. Please note that they are entirely optional but if you are unable to make the session it is really useful if we know in advance. Please let your child's class teacher know so they can be paired up with another family, a friend or school adult.

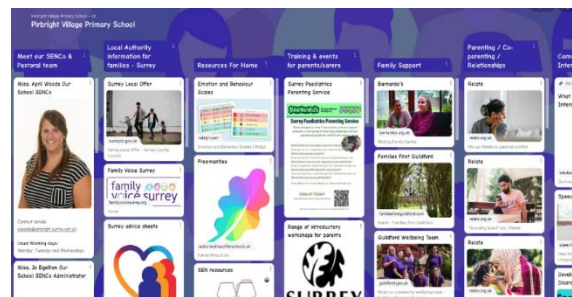


The Nurturing Programme

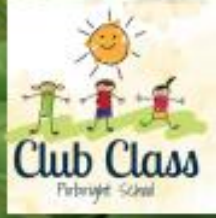
