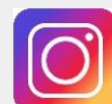

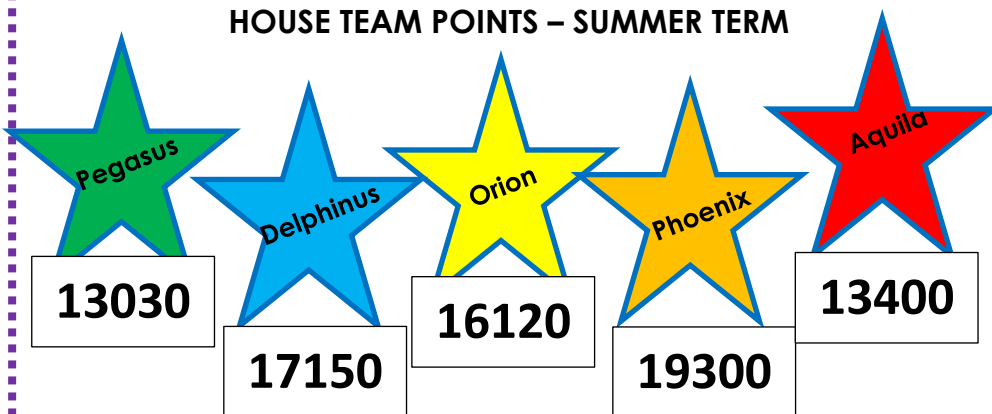

To be eligible, your child must be aged between 2 and 18 and currently experiencing one or more of the following:

- Living with a serious or long-term illness
- Has a registered disability
- Lives in a permanent or temporary care home
- Currently in foster care (supporting documentation may be required)
- Has been recently adopted (within the last 5 years)
- Has been affected by domestic violence or abuse
- Has a parent or legal guardian who is terminally ill
- Has a sibling, parent, or legal guardian who has recently passed away
- Is a registered young carer

Please note that applications are made directly to the charity, and tickets are allocated by them rather than the school. We hope this opportunity may be helpful to some of our families.

We hope you're as excited about Saturday's Fun Run as we are!

We're keeping a close eye on the weather forecast and, due to the **heat warnings** currently in place, we've made a small adjustment to the event schedule to help keep everyone safe.



**REGISTRATION OPENS
8:45AM**

Please ensure you arrive in plenty of time to register so that we can start promptly at 9:15am.

**RUN STARTS
9:15AM**



We will also make a final assessment on Saturday morning regarding the route. Depending on the conditions, we may decide that all participants complete the 1.5-mile route, rather than offering both the 1.5-mile and 3-mile options, to help minimise the risks associated with running in higher temperatures.

TO HELP EVERYONE STAY SAFE & ENJOY THE EVENT, PLEASE:



Arrive well hydrated.



Bring a water bottle with you; some runners may wish to carry one during the run.



Wear light, breathable clothing, with light colours recommended.



Apply sunscreen before arriving and consider bringing a hat or cap.



Listen to your body and slow down, walk, or stop if you feel unwell at any point.



Ensure you and your children are well hydrated before the event.



Water will be available at the finish line for all participants.



As part of your registration, you have already confirmed that you and/or your children are medically fit and able to participate and you do so at your own risk. If anything has changed, or if you are feeling unwell on the day, please leave your trainers at home and sit this one out or come and only walk the route.



Please remember that although the event is fully marshalled, parents and guardians remain responsible for their children throughout the event. You (or your child's emergency contact) must remain on site and be contactable at all times.

Registration opens at 8:45am.

The run will start at 9:15am.



Dogs are unfortunately not able to take part in the run or enter Brookwood Cemetery.

Well-behaved dogs on leads are welcome on the Green.



No smoking or vaping at the event.



Parking around Pirbright Green will be limited, and Avenue de Cagny will be closed.

If you need to travel by car, there will be limited parking available at the school car park on a first-come, first-served basis. Otherwise, please

park considerately and be mindful of local residents.



Please be respectful of the cemetery at all times.



Please note that participant safety is our priority. The organisers reserve the right to amend the route, shorten the event, delay the start, or postpone/cancel the run altogether should weather conditions or any other circumstances make it unsafe to proceed.



And finally, please bring some spare change or your cash card if you can, there will be cakes, tea and coffee available at the pavilion, with all proceeds going directly to FoPS and the school.
