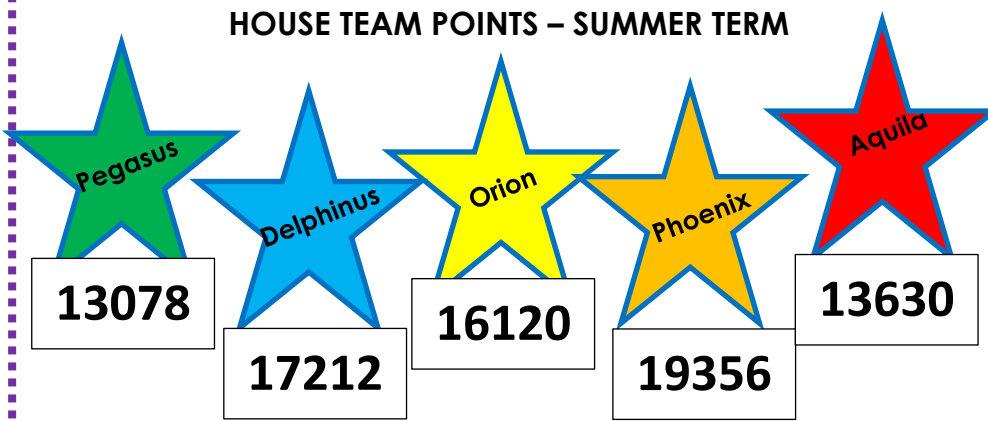

We just wanted to give you early warning that we have a Plan B (and unfortunately a Plan C) in place for The Summer Concert and will give the weather the weekend to be able to have more up to date information; **we will communicate the chosen plan on Monday morning**. Last year, it was very hot and we know we wouldn't do that again. We have consulted with the weather gods and tracked down the data for last year at 6pm and will be able to compare to the predictions for this Thursday and make a decision accordingly. We don't want to let anyone down but we also want the event to be safe and enjoyable for all. We appreciate your support.

*School gates will be open as normal from 8:10am; we will all be here if you need a normal drop off!

Whilst we would love for all the children to return to school and join the fun, we understand that this might not be right for your family so please just liaise with the class teachers and let them know if you are planning on coming back or not. We haven't even started rehearsing yet so give it a few weeks and see how your little humans are feeling!

PLAN B – It's too hot on Thursday evening 😞

– Friday 10th July – Morning Show

- ✓ Adapted Service!
- ✓ Children come to school in their costumes and can stay in them all day (or change into Mufti – optional for them).

Everyone is still invited, but we are asking you to commit to the whole event which usually last about 1.5hr. We cannot accommodate parents coming for some of the show – it's not Sports Day.

If you're coming...

- Gates will be closed and locked at 9:15am
- The show will commence
- We will let you out of the middle gates when we are finished!

All children who are in school will be involved where appropriate.

PLAN C – It is too hot on Thursday evening, Friday morning and/or rehearsal days on Wednesday/Thursday 😬

– Cancellation

Children need to practise. It is a big event and we only do one big whole school practice on Thursday morning but the children also have a Wednesday slot. If it is too hot in the day and/or too hot on Friday (Plan B) morning, then we will have to cancel the event.

PERMISSION TO CYCLE/ WALK TO AND FROM SCHOOL – KS2

In preparation for next year (we do like to be organised!) the form for allowing children to cycle/walk to and from school unaccompanied, is available for you to complete NOW. Your child should not cycle/walk to school until you have completed the form, even if you completed it this year. We insist that all cyclists wear a helmet when cycling to and from school. Reporting Absence

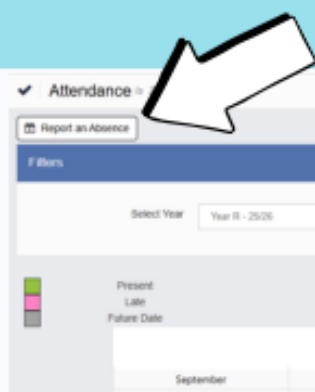

To be eligible, your child must be aged between 2 and 18 and currently experiencing one or more of the following:

- Living with a serious or long-term illness
- Has a registered disability
- Lives in a permanent or temporary care home
- Currently in foster care (supporting documentation may be required)
- Has been recently adopted (within the last 5 years)
- Has been affected by domestic violence or abuse
- Has a parent or legal guardian who is terminally ill
- Has a sibling, parent, or legal guardian who has recently passed away
- Is a registered young carer

Please note that applications are made directly to the charity, and tickets are allocated by them rather than the school. We hope this opportunity may be helpful to some of our families.
